DoodleMaths and DoodleTables

Years 1-6

Dear Parents and Carers,

In order to set up and start using DoodleMaths and DoodleTables, please see the information below from the Doodle team. You will need to use the correct class code for your child; these are also listed below.

Y2 - Hobbits: 4X44DY

Y2 - Goblins: 3CRBKG

When choosing a username and password, we suggest something simple and easy to remember! You might like to use the same username and password that you have for Accelerated Reader; this is the first letter of your first name, followed by the first four letters of your surname (for example: ctrib) with 'abc' as the password.

Year 5 and 6 children who have already created an account during the trial period will be able to continue using the same login details as before.

Please do get your child set up as soon as possible and make use of this brilliant resource!



A little bit about Doodle

Doodle improves children's confidence and ability in maths and English. Using the apps for just 10 minutes a day is proven to help children make three months of progress in just one month! The intelligent algorithm powering the apps learns what your child's strengths and weaknesses are and builds a personalised work programme tailored around them.

How to get started

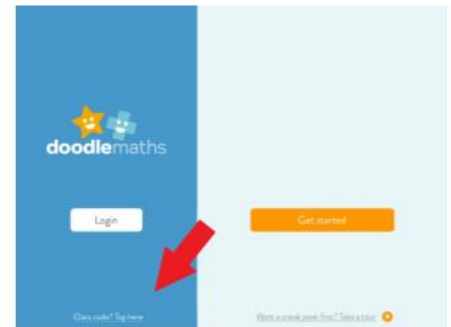
1. Watch this student launch video with your child/ren: <https://vimeo.com/400533853>

2. Download the free DoodleMaths app to get started (on an Apple, Android or Amazon device). Or you can use the web browser version on your PC or laptop: students.doodlemaths.com. Follow the instructions in the video for how to log in using a class code

3. Use the maths class code that matches your child's class.

The first time you use Doodle, you will tap on 'Class code? Tap here'.

After you have created an account, you can just log in using the 'login' button in the middle.

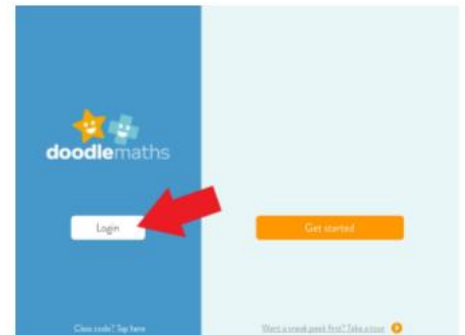
When your child logs into the Doodle apps, there is a purple grown-ups button. You can create a parent account here and it will automatically link to your child's account.

DoodleEnglish and DoodleSpell

Years 1-6

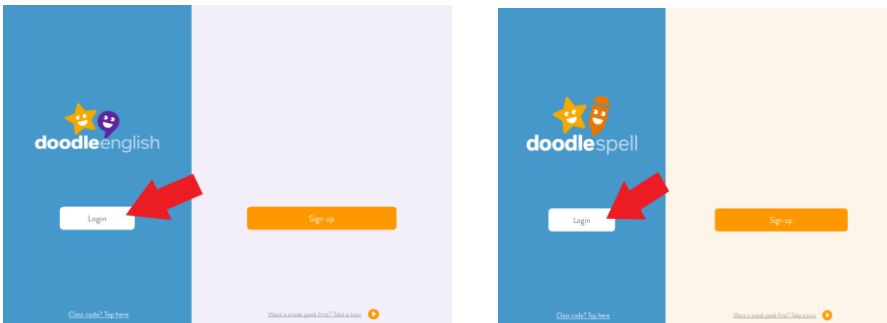
Dear Parents and Carers,

We have now activated both DoodleEnglish and DoodleSpell for Years 1 to 6. These resources work in a similar way to the maths elements that your child has been using.

From now on, our children will have full access to these two apps as well as DoodleMaths and DoodleTables.

Your child can use their DoodleMaths username and password to access all four programmes: DoodleMaths, DoodleTables, DoodleEnglish and DoodleSpell. There is no need to use a class code for DoodleSpell and DoodleEnglish if you have already set up an account.

Simply tap the 'login' button in the middle of the page and use your Doodle username and password as normal.



The apps for both Doodle English and Doodle Spell are available to download for free from Apple, Android and Amazon.
