As communicated over the last few days, our EYFS and KS1 sports day session is scheduled for tomorrow, **Tuesday 3rd June**.

The weather has been lovely up until now and, in true summer term style, it seems like our luck may be running out and we have been watching the BBC and Met Office forecast closely as they track one particular band of rain due to reach us during the early hours and into the start of the school day tomorrow.

Current field and ground conditions, along with the projected wind speed and direction, seems to indicate that we should still be able to operate a safe and fun sports day for the children!

However, to give the weather front the best chance possible to have passed through, we are going to **delay** the start of the morning event for **Years 1 and 2** until **10:00 am**.

Therefore, the **gates** will now open at **9:40am**

In addition to children wearing their PE kits, trainers and hoodies, it is essential that a **waterproof jacket or coat** is named and in school too.

Nursery and Reception: the weather is forecast to be drier and clearer for the afternoon and so all arrangements remain the same - **gates open at 1:15 pm**, collection of your child from the nursery or reception classes will be as normal at the end of sports day.

It is our advice that you also come prepared for the weather and so bring waterproof coats and jackets, along with umbrellas and any mats or chairs that you would like to use to sit on.

We hope you enjoy your time with us and thank you for your help and support in keeping our children safe and comfortable during their sports day.
