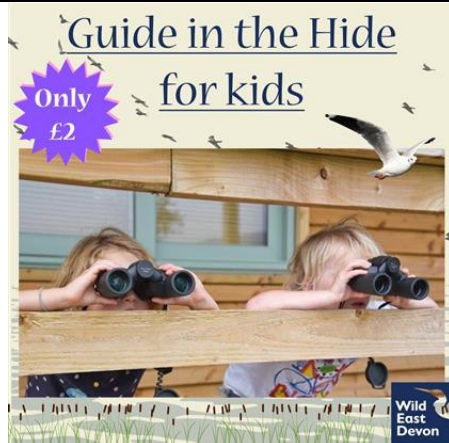
The Story of the Earth

Get out and about! Walks in East Devon

Roundball Wood

Roundball Wood is a small area of woodland to the south of Honiton. Three footpaths lead to the Wood from public roads (Woodhill View, Battishorne Way and Roundball Lane) and the Wood is about 10 minutes' walk from either of these points. This is a circular walk lasting about an hour.

From the south side of Honiton, parking is off road. The nearest postcode is EX14 2FP.

Please take reasonable care and go dressed and equipped for rough walking. Maps available at: www.eastdevonaonb.org.uk



The climb up to the **Dumpdon Iron Age Hill Fort**, is well worth the effort and offers fantastic views of the surrounding area. Explore these impressive defensive earthworks before visiting the mysterious small beech forest behind. There are no signposts to Dumpdon Hill but it is on Dumpdon Lane, near Beacon, Honiton, Devon, EX14

Knapp Copse



Knapp Copse Nature Reserve is half way between Honiton and Sidmouth, off the A375, not far from the Hare and Hounds Pub.

There is a well-marked route of about 1.5 miles, although it does include some steep paths. The nearest postcode is EX10 0QG. There is a small carpark at the entrance. For more details and directions see Wild East Devon Nature Reserve [website here](#)

Offwell Woods



Offwell is just off the A35 about 3 miles from Honiton. There is parking at the village hall which is 100 metres from the school and the Church. Postcode EX14 9SA.

You can find the walk by heading down the lane by the side of the Church for about 200 metres until you reach a kissing gate on the right that opens up into a large field, with a public footpath across the field towards the woodland. It is a 20 min walk from the village to the woodland centre.
