Choose two or more of the following activities to bring into school. Help us make our displays look wonderful and learn a bit about our exciting new topic!

Remember, these are only suggestions, be creative!

Design and create your own pyramid just like the Ancient Egyptians did. Think about what materials you could use and be creative - maybe lego, papier-mâché or even cake?!

What was civilisation like in Ancient Egypt? Find out about what people wore, ate, the jobs that they had and if there was a difference between the rich and poor.

Create a piece of art relating to Ancient Egypt - you might need to begin by researching the different types of art in Ancient Egypt.

Send us a coded message in Hieroglyphics; make sure each symbol is accurate so that we can decode it!

Many pharaohs were followed in Ancient Egypt. Research and find out about one and create a factfile. You may choose to include images of them or create your own drawings of them!

Create a fact-file on a famous Ancient Egyptian, for example Tutankhamun or Nefertiti

After mummification, people were buried in a tomb wearing a death mask. Design a death mask for Tutankhamun.

What were some of the religious beliefs in Ancient Egypt? What did they believe in? Find out and create a presentation or a poster to share.

Learn what mummification is and what the processes were. Can you mummify a tomato?
